## Appendix 1

### Re – ‘Permission to Play’ - General Information

‘Permission to Play’ is a facility in our rules that allow players to play for a Club other than their **own** in certain circumstances. For example, a player who is a member of a football only club may seek permission to play hurling with a hurling club and vice versa where a player who is a member of a hurling only club may want to play football with separate football club.

In order to do this, the player(s) must get permission from the County Board at the start of each year and all such requests must be made prior to March 1 of that year. Any request received after March 1 will be refused.

***No player is eligible to play with another club other than his own club team unless such permission is sought and granted.***

‘Permission to play’ does not mean a transfer nor does it in any way change the status of the player in the sense he is still and will continue to be a **member of his own club**. All this facility allows is an opportunity for a player to play with another club where his own club is not in a position to compete.

From 2018 onwards all ‘Permission to Play’ applicants must complete a ‘Permission to Play’ Application Form. **No ‘Permission to Play’ will be granted unless accompanied by completed Application Form.**

Note: Application Form need only be completed by a player once, it does not have to be completed each year.

In relation to fixtures (including championship) the unavailability of any player whose involvement is due to having received ‘Permission to Play’ will not constitute a valid reason for seeking a postponement of said fixture.

### **Kerry County Committee Bye-Laws 2018**

#### **5.1 Attachment to First Club**

In accordance with Rule 6.4 (b) O.G 2017, a person first becoming a member of the Association as a Youth Member or a Full Member (as appropriate) shall be entitled to join a Club **only in the Parish of his/her permanent residence** subject to;

- (a) A person in permanent residence in a town of more than one Club and/or Parish shall be entitled to join any Club in that town.
- (b) A person in permanent residence in a County Committee designated “Open Area” shall be entitled to join any named Club in that specified “Open Area”

#### **Note:**

For the purpose of these Bye Laws:

PARISH shall be, subject to County Boundaries, the area under the jurisdiction of a Parish Priest or Administrator as pertained on the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2013

PERMANENT RESIDENCE shall mean residing at a fixed address which the CCC considers to be his private principal place of residence for 96 weeks prior to current 1<sup>st</sup> March.

OPEN AREA shall mean a specified area overlapping neighbouring parish boundaries designated by the County Committee as “open to two or more named Clubs”
